



## H4A 2021 Criteria Scoring Matrix

**Proposed Criteria & Scoring:** Criteria will be used to provide an initial scoring mechanism of proposals submitted.

Organizations will have an opportunity to score proposals immediately after presentations. Scores will be averaged and used, primarily, as a tool to identify potential Tier 1 proposals. Only average scores of 35 and above will be considered for Tier I agenda items.

New funding proposals must clearly identify the funding source and an amount or close estimate.

**Strongly Opposed (1), Oppose (2), Somewhat support (3), Support (4), Strongly Support (5)**
